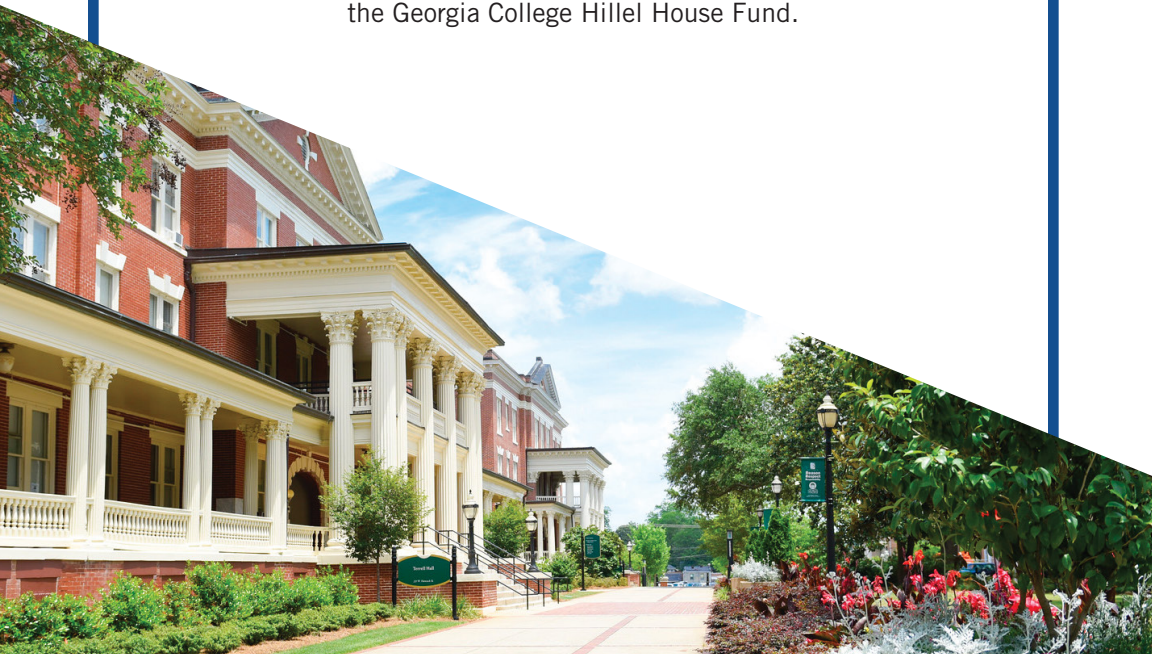


The Path Towards Growth

A dedicated lounge is a common space for students to relax, enjoy each other’s company, and take a break from their studies.

Dedicated meeting rooms provide students space to meet and hone their leadership skills. Students will learn how to cook traditional Jewish recipes in our kosher kitchen; and ensure no matter the time of year, they have something delicious to eat. Finally, a screened in patio and beautiful garden will give students an outdoor space for Sukkot and Tu B’Svat celebrations and a beautiful place to relax.
